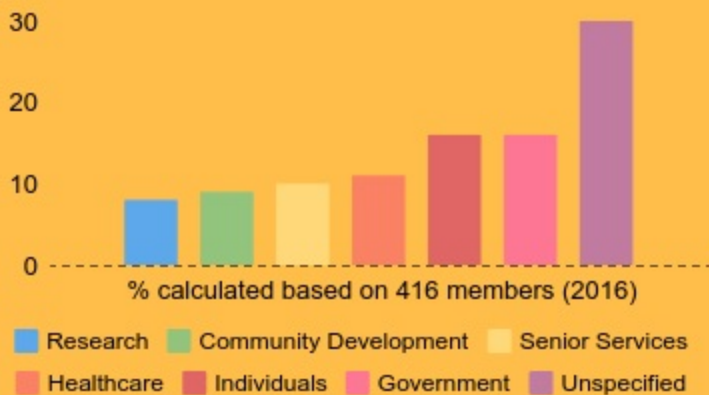
- **To create opportunities** for stakeholders, older adults and individuals of all ages to rethink and reshape how we view and incorporate aging in our communities.
